

What We've been learning...



Reception have blown us away in maths this week. The children have been comparing quantities. They have been using their 'talking partners' during class inputs to say which group had more or less. They have then gone on to say why and prove this using practical apparatus.

During our challenge activities in continuous provision the children were using their reasoning skills to say how a tower with less blocks could be taller than a tower with more blocks. In English, the children have been writing lists of food that they would take on their animal hunt. We used the bananas from our snack bowl to make banana bread. It was yummy!





#OLGHY1

What We've been learning...



Another fantastic week in Y1! In English, we learned about acrostic poems and then started our own creation about spiders. Our maths lessons focused on the number line up to 20. During basic skills, Y1 worked on representing numbers up to 10 on a rekenrek, exploring how efficiently we could display them with just one push on the top row.

In music, Y1 experimented with timbre and dynamics, creating a captivating whole-class piece inspired by the underwater world. In science, we've begun a new topic on seasonal changes in winter. This week, we learned that in winter, the amount of daylight decreases, nights lengthen, the weather becomes colder, and some trees lose all their leaves.

What We've been learning...



In maths, we have started our topic on money and have been recalling what notes and coins we have. In English, we have continued to work on biographies and used our reading skills to collect facts about Florence Joyner. We have started our new science topics about plants and looked at what the parts of a plant are. In geography, we have been looking at the world map and its continents and oceans in the past few weeks.

Now, we have moved onto focus on identifying the continent of Africa and finding where Kenya is located within the continent. This week, we have finished our Re topic about books that are used within the parish. Our focus in collective worship this week is 'called to follow and we reflected on how we can follow God's word.

What We've been learning...



In English, we are very proud of the sentences that we have written, which have excellent vocabulary. We have enjoyed writing our story based around the Magic Paintbrush, by Julia Donaldson. In maths, we have been developing our understanding of multiplication.

In RE, we have been exploring the Joyful Mysteries of the rosary. It has been been good to share our understanding of the different stories. In science, we have been looking at light and how light is reflected. In music, we have been learning how to sing together with use actions to develop our performance.





#OLGHY4

What We've been learning...



This week has been another great week of learning in Year 4, with lots of wonderful attitudes to learning. In maths, we've multiplied and added, we've used informal methods to multiply as well as multiplying two and three digits by single digit numbers. In English, we have completed our sentence stacking lessons for Aladdi.

Now, we are beginning to plan our own narrative, using personification, dialogue, similes and metaphors. In geography, we have discussed how coastal landforms are formed. In history, we have looked at Boudicca and her taking the fight back to the Romans. In art, we have created 2D shapes, making them 3D. In RE, we have continued our work on the local community.

What We've been learning...



We have had another wonderful week in Year 5! In our reading lessons, we looked closely at the poem 'The Longest Journey' and we worked hard to answer some key questions about the text. We also started a new topic in maths—multiplication and division. We practised multiplying 3 and 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers.

In geography, we looked at Semra's migration story and we also thought about some geographical enquiry questions that we could ask. During RE this week, we found out what a diocese is and we created a coat of arms to represent a diocese. Next week is NSPCC Number Day so we will be doing lots of fun maths activities in class!





#OLGHy6

What We've been learning...



This week has seen Year 6 work very hard and show off their skills in each subject. We have continued our book called Varmints, working on sentence structure. In maths, we have been learning about decimals involving the four operations. Meanwhile, in RE, we have learnt the importance of the Bible and have been able to locate scripture within it. n science, we completed an investigation on how what happens when you increase the voltage.

IWe have also been learning about internal and international migration in geography and using our own examples to explain this as a class. In history we have also been learning about the fight for rule between the Kingdom of Wessex and the Vikings. Meanwhile in art, we have been planning out our art work which involves 'making our voice heard' using the skills we have learnt throughout the topic.


