'Be cured!' And the leprosy left him at once and he was cured. Jesus immediately sent him away and sternly ordered him, 'Mind you say nothing to anyone, but go and show yourself to the priest, and make the offering for your healing prescribed by Moses as evidence of your recovery.' The man went away, but then started talking about it freely and telling the story everywhere, so that Jesus could no longer go openly into any town, but had to stay outside in places where nobody lived. What we've been Learning...



Reception has been talking about how the characters in the story of 'The Gruffalo' may have felt and what they may have been thinking at different points during the story. They then took time to say their sentences out loud and used their phonics knowledge to begin to write sentences. We are so proud of the progress that every single child in the class has made not only in phonics.

In maths, the children have loved investigating which objects are longer or shorter than another object. We've had a great week celebrating children's mental health week. We cannot believe that we are halfway through the year and are excited for lots more fun learning after half term.





#OLGHY1

What we've been Learning...



What a wonderful end to this half term! Y1 had a fantastic day wearing their own clothes to express themselves for Mental Health Week. We had a fantastic interactive livestream about mental health, and then we practiced some breathing exercises and drew things that make us happy. In English, we have been working very hard on retelling the story 'Lost and Found'.

After half term, we will be writing our own 'Lost and Found' story and thinking about how the characters we choose impact the setting. In maths, we have been looking at number bonds to 20 and doubles. We enjoyed making doubles with our partners. In science, we have started a new topic on animals, and we have been learning about mammals and how all mammals have fur. We then discussed how some mammals live in the wild and some are pets.

What we've been learning...



To celebrate children's mental health week we took part in a livestream event which taught us some strategies to help us feel happier. We also took part in safer internet day on Tuesday and learnt all about pop-ups when using the internet and how to safely tell an adult.


We began a new focus text in English this week called Last stop on Market Street. We have been learning how to use onomatopoeia, adverbs and repetition for effect in narrative writing. To complete our 3D sculptures topic in art we have created tile houses where we attached 3D pieces to the flat tile house.

In English, we have written and edited our stories. We have been great at editing to make improvements to our writing. In maths, we have been exploring division. We have been developing our written strategies and solving word problems.

In art, we have completed our abstract 3D sculptures. We enjoyed adding the finishing touches. This week in PE, we have been working on our traveling in gymnastics. In geography, we have been learning about London, using geographical language.

What we've been learning...



Although it is our last week of half term, we have continued to work incredibly hard in all of our subjects. Well done, Year 4. In maths, we have been working on the perimeter of a rectangle. In English, we are planning, discussing and researching a balanced argument based on should animals be kept in zoos? In RE, we have completed our work on community and what this looks like in our local parish.

In history, we discussed Hadrian's wall and the significance it has. In geography, we have continued our work on coastal processes and researched coastal habitats. In art this week, we have worked with wire and sculpted shapes. In science this week, we are investigating how pitch can be changed. We've also been learning how to stay safe online and how to look after our own mental health.

We have had another great week of learning in Y5. In English, we enjoyed writing our own poems based on 'The Highwayman'. We used a repeated refrain throughout the poem to create the rhythm of the horse running. During our RE lessons, we researched different Christian denominations including Anglican and Methodist. We found out lots of interesting facts!

In geography, we looked at how migration can change places. As part of Children's Mental Health Week, we took part in an interactive livestream video based on the theme 'speak up'. We also enjoyed wearing our own clothes to school to express ourselves! After half term, we will be reading the book Cosmic in our English lessons.

Y6 have had a really busy week. In English, we have written up our wonderful narratives about an animal facing and overcoming a threat. Meanwhile in maths, we are growing ever more confident of converting fractions, decimals and percentages. Meanwhile, we have learnt about refugees in migration. As part of mental health week, we have also had a 'Children's Mental Health' awareness online session, where we created a mood board, we have had a session from Bully Busters and also completed different scenarios on Safer Internet Day. 
