Y3 and Y6 were joint attendance winners this week with 95% attendance all week - well done!









What We've been learning...



Reception are so excited to have live caterpillars in our classroom. They are watching them grow bigger each day. They have been learning about the life cycle of a butterfly. See if your child can tell you about the four stages. The children have been taking part in lots of activities in continuous provision to develop their fine motor skills, like cutting and sticking pictures to show the life cycle of an animal.

In maths, they have been using their knowledge of numbers to 10 and their number bond facts to subtract numbers from 10 this week. The children have taken part in practical activities, singing songs and using different apparatus to show how to subtract.

What We've been learning...



This week, Year 1 has worked so hard completing their spring quizzes. It was great to have a chance to demonstrate everything we have been learning and all the progress we have made. In RE, we have been learning about how Jesus taught in the temple and the important messages that Jesus shared with people.

In geography, we learned about Wales. We thought about some key landmarks in Wales such as Snowdon and St. David's Cathedral. We also learned about traditional food dishes for Wales such as cawl and Welsh cakes. In science, we have been sorting animals into different groups depending on their features.

IWe had a fantastic time at Imagine That on Wednesday and learnt all about new things! We took part in some science investigations with dry ice, made slime and even created snow! Then in the afternoon, we were able to paint magnets and play in the small world area, which included dressing up!

In DT we used our planning from last week to begin making our model ferris wheels in groups, which include a wheel and axle that will make the wheel spin when it is complete. In RE, we have been learning about Ash Wednesday and Lent and discussed how the ashes of palm leaves are used.






