I am delighted to be able to share with you the outcome and the full report of our recent RE Inspection on 20th and 21st March 2024. We are so pleased that the inspectors recognised and celebrated all that we have achieved together at Our Lady of Good Help Catholic Primary School.

There are 3 areas of judgement - Catholic life and mission, Religious Education and Prayer & Liturgy (Collective Worship) - which are then broken down into 3 sections each. OLGH was rated as **Good** overall and **OUTSTANDING** in all three areas of Catholic Life!

Our wonderful children, as always, shone brightly and their outstanding behaviour was recognised as well as the respect they show for themselves and others. Our children know that they are unique... "God chose us to be different and He blessed us with our differences." The inspectors were extremely keen to stress that our mission statement, 'Like Our Lady, we live wisely, think deeply and love generously, in Christ,' is clearly lived out in school by all staff and this impacts strongly on the inclusive and welcoming atmosphere in our school, "Relationships are exemplary and there is a strong culture of welcome and care for all...The culture of inclusivity for all, ensures that all pupils, regardless of their culture, religion, ability or background, have the highest quality of care and commitment to reach their full potential."
