


# @OLGHEYFS

What we've been learning...



Reception has enjoyed learning the story of 'Supertato' this week. They made their own story maps and used their phonics knowledge to help them with their writing. The children are working on being able to write a sentence independently. They have been talking about and using crafts and construction materials to make traps to catch 'Evil Pea.'

In maths, the children have been counting to and from 20. They have been making numbers to twenty using tens frames. They are enjoying keeping score in PE when working with a partner to hit a target.





# #OLGHY1

What we've been learning...



This week, Y1 started a new topic in English called "Brian's Bear's Picnic." We have been focusing on describing the bear and sequencing the events in the story. In maths, we've been using non-standard units to measure the mass of a variety of objects, finding joy in comparing their masses with balance scales. In RE we explored the story of the road to Emmaus, we made our own road with oil pastels and role played the story with puppets.

Additionally, in science, we wrapped up our unit on caring for the environment and transitioned to learning about the changes in spring. We went on a spring walk, documenting our observations in our book. During Parents' Evening, we were delighted to share our outstanding achievements with our parents.





# #OLGHy2

## What we've been learning...



We have been learning about the Stone Age in history and looked at cave paintings this week. We also learnt about the meaning of prehistoric. During English, we have begun a new book called The Owl who is Afraid of the Dark. We have been looking at onomatopoeia and using adjectives to add more information into our sentences.

We have been learning about The day of the Pentecost and used our understanding of the scripture to create a storyboard. We have been learning about capacity and volume and measuring with litres and millilitres.





# #OLGHy3

What we've been learning...



Y3 have had a great week. We have loved developing sentences for our story based on Theseus and the Minotaur. We are really thinking about the language that we are using. In history, we have been exploring the wars of ancient Greece and were able to recall interesting information about them. In RE. we have been reflecting on how the Holy Spirit fills us with strength to make the right choices and the courage to carry them out.

In art, we have been looking at the developing ideas for ancient scrolls based on images of ancient Egypt. We are particularly good at sharing our ideas. In PE, we have loved going swimming this week and last. Such determination from a lot of the class! In maths, we have been learning about mass with a particular focus on reading different scales. We have loved using Hit the Button to develop our fluency skills.





# #OLGHy4

What we've been learning...



Well done to Year 4, for a great week of learning. During maths this week, we have focussed on decimals, comparing them, making whole numbers using tenths and hundredths and partitioned decimals. In English, we are continuing to write our tour of the Water Cycle. We are using scientific facts, repetition, positive adjectives and parenthesis.

We are continuing our topic in history, discussing a high and holy place. In the current Ethiopia. In geography, we have discussed sustainable tourism and how we keep tourism sustainable over years. In RE, we have continued our work on Pentecost. We have discussed the Ethiopian receiving the new life in Jesus as well as the story of Paul.

What we've been learning...



What a fantastic week in year 5! We have been busy in our English lessons planning and writing our own transmission from space! In maths, we started a new topic about geometry including properties of shapes. We enjoyed using a protractor to measure different angles. During RE lessons, we made links between scripture and God's gift of the Holy Spirit.

We also really enjoyed our PE lessons this week, practising our skills in both badminton and cricket. During geography, we explored the different parts of the Amazon river including the source and the mouth. Next week we will be starting a new English unit based on the book 'Kick'.
