'You are not far from the kingdom of God'

One of the scribes came up to Jesus and put a question to him, 'Which is the first of all the commandments?' What we've been learning...



Reception have started the topic 'Space' and have enjoyed learning about what food astronauts take to Space. In English, they have been learning the story 'Whatever Next.' They have been making their own rocket ships just like the character Baby Bear did in the story. They have re-told the story and used this to help them write their own sentences.

In maths, the children have been using their knowledge of shape to problem solve. They have been using shapes to make different shapes. They then used these to make their own rocket pictures.

What we've been learning...



This week, Y1 has been working hard to prepare for their phonics screening checks. We have had lots of fun playing phonics games such as phonics bingo. In English, we have been planning an alternative ending to the story "The Magic Paintbrush." We then wrote our own stories, which were amazing.

In maths, we have been learning about making equal groups and sharing equally. We have also started learning about fractions and recognising and finding shapes.
